

Application for Rocky Hill Congregational Church Scholarship

GUIDELINES FOR ELIGIBILITY AND AWARD

- 1. Applicant must be a member of Rocky Hill Congregational Church, one of its youth organizations, or an active participant in the life of the church. (If applicant is currently living at school away from Rocky Hill, involvement in church at place of residence should be described).
- 2. Applicant must be a graduating high school senior and/or student who has successfully completed one year at an accredited postsecondary educational institution.
- 3. Applicants pursuing a masters degree or further education may apply.
- 4. Applicants will be considered on the basis of service to the church, financial need, and community service/extracurricular activities.
- 5. Applications must be thoroughly completed to be considered.
- 6. Applications must be received by RHCC Scholarship Committee no later than April 15.
- 7. Scholarship recipients are responsible for notifying RHCC immediately if changes affecting information in the application occur prior to beginning of the academic year.
- 8. Scholarship funds will be paid directly to the awardee.
- 9. All information in the application will be maintained as personal and confidential except for the non-financial information that may be shared during awards presentations.
- 10. The amount awarded to recipients will be dependent upon the amount available in any given year and on the number and qualifications of selected recipients, participation in church activities and on personal merit.
- 11. Applications will be reviewed on a yearly basis therefore it is the **applicants**' responsibility to reapply yearly.
- 12. Scholarships to graduating seniors will be presented in the applicant's school awards assembly program. Otherwise, recipients will be notified by letter. Scholarship checks will be paid to the applicant and notification of change of plans or non-attendance should be made to the committee prior to issuance of checks in mid-July and mid-December.
