

#### LIGHTING OF THE ADVENT CANDLES

Reader One: We are a people of hope. Our hearts are full of anticipation for the coming of our beloved Christ Child. For God is to be among us and we will see a great light in the midst of our night. Let us light the Candle of Hope. *The first candle is lit.* 

Reader Two: We are a people who seek peace. We know that God has told us to turn our weapons of war into instruments that benefit all humanity. In the name of that Child who was born long ago to become the Prince of Peace, we now light the Candle of Peace.

#### LIGHTING OF THE CHRIST CANDLE

Through the season of Advent, we have been watching, waiting, praying, for the coming of light into the world.

All: We have lit the candles of peace, hope, joy and love, longing for the day when the things of darkness – selfishness and greed, suffering and oppression – shall be no more.

Tonight we light the Christ candle as we celebrate the birth of the one in whom God's light has come. We pray that as we follow him in the ways of love, God's light will be born anew in us and in our world. The Christ candle is lit.
