
#### \*GATHERING PRAYER AND THE LORD'S PRAYER





# WEDNESDAY SCRIPTURE STUDY will resume with the Gospel of Thomas

Weekly Scripture study will resume on **Wednesdays**, 12:00 – 1:00, beginning on **January 14**. The first text we will look at will be **The Gospel of Thomas**. Discovered in 1945, it is one of the several gospels we now know existed in early Christian times but was not included in the canon of the New Testament. Copies of the text will be made available at the first session. No need for any particular background, come and explore what the Gospel of Thomas says that Jesus taught... and see how it compares with what we are familiar with from the gospels we know.
